Stakeholders of Extension service in Tajikistan

 150 staff, but only 30% involved **Ministry of Agriculture** 800 staff on crop and horticulture, mostly on Tajik Academy of Agriculture research, but only 15% involved on extension Science on crop and Horticulture graduate 400 every Tajik Agrarian University year, but only 3-4% to sector 450 staff, only 15% involved Gov. Extension specialist at villages 350 staff, 75% involved Private sector 500 staff, mostly on project indicators, 25% **NGO** and projects

Total: 2,250 involved, but 600 of them could provide professional extension service







Outreach of Extension service



From 180 thousand farms professional service covered 5 % only



From 800 thousand ha of arable only 13,8% covered by professional extension services



More then 90% of farmers needs professional extension services!








